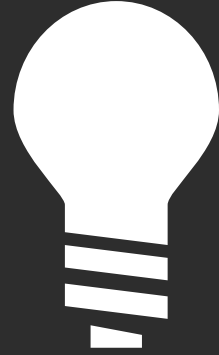

Mobile vertical (3a), mobile boom (3b)

Course overview:

The aim of the course is to provide trainees with theoretical knowledge and practical skills which will enable them to understand the role and responsibilities of a powered access Operator (Driver). Following successful completion of the course, trainees receive a powered access licence with the relevant categories based on the course completed (PAL Card), certificate, safety guide and logbook.

Course structure:

The training courses are carried out over a duration as stated above and follow a theoretical training followed by a theoretical test before moving onto the practical training with a practical test on the categories being delivered.

Course content:

Introduction/ pre-theory test/ regulations and guidance/ MEWP categories/ structural parts/ familiarisation & pre-use inspection/ platform movement and travel/ ground conditions/ working envelope/ operation/ post-theory test/pre-use checks/ practical test/ verbal questions.

Q & A

What will be required to deliver the training On Site?

Before we can offer this training On Site you will be required to sign up for a delivery standards form confirming that required equipment and areas needed for the delivery of the training and testing can and will be provided by yourselves and that it meets all the IPAF accredited standard requirements. This will be quoted at a per-course rate

What practical exercises will I be asked to complete?

Operator (driver) test on category being delivered. Delegates will be questioned on their knowledge of their MEWP either before or after the test to ensure they have acquired a basic understanding of their MEWP.

What qualification will I gain from this course?

Powered access licence (PAL Card) and certificate, valid for 5 years.

What is the course duration? As shown above, this is based on the course being delivered and the number of delegates completing the course and their knowledge and experience.

Will I have to take an assessment?

Delegates are evaluated by means of a pre-theory test to see what they already know and a post-theory test to see what they have learnt. The instructor identifies if there are any areas where the delegates may need assistance to ensure the learning outcomes are achieved before undertaking the post-theory test and practical assessment.

What are the course prerequisites?

Good written and verbal understanding of English. Users should be physically fit and in good health. If you have any problems with literacy or language comprehension or have any doubts about your fitness to use a MEWP, you must bring them to the attention of your employer.
